SUBMISSION GUIDELINES for FPAC Gallery 2011-2012

Please read before filling out the Application Form

WHO WE ARE: The Fort Point Arts Community, Inc. of South Boston (FPAC) is a non-profit founded in 1980 to enrich the Fort Point area with an artists live/work population that contributes to the district's and the City of Boston's cultural life. In Fort Point, artists not only create art, we develop permanent studio space, organize art lending programs, run two galleries and a store, and are active participants in determining the future of our neighborhood.

THE GALLERY: The Fort Point Arts Community Gallery opened in October 1995 and is dedicated to supporting artistic creation through exhibitions and public programs of local and regional artists. The FPAC Gallery is a 1,000+ square foot space at 300 Summer Street in Boston. We are currently accepting proposals for our upcoming exhibition 2011/2012 Season. Each exhibition runs approximately 8 weeks. For more information please see the FPAC web site at www.fortpointarts.org.

JUROR: Randi Hopkins, Independent curator, co-founder and former co-director of Boston's Allston Skirt Gallery, Associate Curator at Boston's Institute of Contemporary Art from Fall 2008 through Summer 2011.

PROPOSALS: Proposals must include the following materials:

- Application Form
- Description of Exhibition Theme or Concept (not to exceed 500 words)
- Educational Component (not to exceed 500 words)

All proposals must include an educational component. A gallery talk by the artists or curators is required. Additional possibilities include, but are not limited to: panel discussions, special activities, demonstrations, or outreach to community groups or schools.

- Application Fee
- List of names of participating artists and their resumes, indicating 1 contact person
- CD of Digital Images and/or DVD

CD: Submit no more than 20 jpeg images (maximum of 1200 pixels in any dimension) on 1 CD with a maximum of 10 images per artist. Each image must be labeled with artist name/s and title.

DVD for film or performance (not to exceed 3 minutes)

- List of Images & image information including artists' names, titles, dates, media & dimensions.
- Self Addressed Stamped Envelope for return of submission materials with appropriate postage for return of materials. Materials without return postage will be discarded. *FPAC is not responsible for lost materials.*

Artists who have had a proposal accepted and exhibited by the FPAC Gallery are not eligible to submit another proposal for two years following their exhibition.
