## Call For Art: Mentoring 2012

The Art at 12 Gallery seeks submissions for *Mentoring*, a group show **March 8 – April 30, 2012**. We invite submissions from Fort Point artists who are educators, serve as faculty in college art departments, teach art in local schools, or teach in community-based art programs. The show will feature the art of artist-educators alongside select work by their current students.

You may submit works of any size or in any media for the show. Student work from the current academic year is preferred. Student work from any level is eligible (grade school, secondary school, undergraduate, graduate, continuing education.) A PDF of the call is attached.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

**Interested teachers should submit their entries and their students' by 6pm February 24, 2012:** Faculty artwork: one image each of one to two pieces of work Student artwork: one piece per student for up to six students, larger numbers of student work will be considered if part of a group installation piece.

**Please include the following:** - Name of institution- The teacher's resume, cv or brief bio - The teacher's images (jpg, tiff, or pdf)- The students' names and images (jpg, tiff or pdf)

Submissions are due to the Art at 12 Gallery Committee by 6pm February 24, 2012. The committee will select those submissions that best exemplify the notion of mentorship. The quantity of student work accommodated per faculty person will be based on the number of faculty submissions received.

**Notification:** Applicants will be notified by February 27, 2012.

**Art drop-off:** Selected applicants must drop-off submissions at the gallery March 5 - 7, 2012. All work must be ready to hang and the teacher should be prepared to assist with installing student work.

**Show dates:** March 8 – April 30, 2012. A public reception will be held March 8, 2012, 5-8pm.

**Participation fee:** \$25 per teacher (no charge for students) This is not a submission fee, it is a gallery fee is for selected applicants to cover printing costs for posters and post cards and refreshments for the opening.

**Commissions:** The Art at 12 Gallery charges the following commissions on works sold: 25% non-FPAC members, 15% FPAC members, 10% MIFP members. If a work is sold, it will remain in the show until the show closes. The purchaser may pick it up after the show closes.

**Please note:** All applications must come from a teacher, not a student. The teacher must be an FPAC member, or must reside or have a studio in Fort Point.
